In December 2002, a group of Hollywood actors spoke out against the United States war-mongering against Iraq. Their initial message was that it was patriotic and responsible to speak out against U.S. policy that seemed to be at odds with the greater good.

These actors began what has grown into a huge waging peace movement within the U.S.A. and around the world. Hundreds of thousands of individuals across the planet were expressing themselves, and even a U.S. congressman or two. But the general American population had muffled itself into a silent support (silent consentience) for leadership, even though leadership was a bit murky in its interpretation of the issues.

Out of the initial 100 or so actors who signed a statement decreeing that there were better solutions available has come a huge surge of response that is exciting in its possibilities. Several groups, including Hollywood's Win Without War Coalition,³ and MoveOn.org,⁴ created a series of Web sites that initiated the first virtual march on the planet. On February 6, 2003, Washington senators and other top U.S. officials were systematically bombarded with phone calls, faxes and e-mails in opposition to the U.S. war effort. Approximately one million calls and faxes were received by elected officials in one day, and a huge new momentum was initiated. The first virtual march for peace was a meteoric success.

All that was required was to register on a Web site in response to several broadcast e-mails that were in circulation. Registration was quick and easy: your name, your time availability, zip code and a statement if you wished. What came back in a matter of one day was an auto-generated e-mail informing you of the time of your calls and whom to call. Another auto-generated e-mail was sent the day before your call, reminding you of your commitment and the time of your calls, which were spaced four minutes apart.

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With the help of the Electronics Age, participants, with telephones in hand and computer screens to light the way, were advised about their local representatives and phone numbers, and the first virtual march began. The computer screens also reminded “the marchers” of their earlier statement, should they care to use them, as well as a reminder that the recipient offices were staffed by individuals and that kindness and diplomacy would be useful tools in getting the message across.

As it was, the phone lines and circuitry of Washington, D.C., reverberated to a new part of America speaking up. A digital part of America had found its voice – a nonviolent response with minimal expense and time commitment, had come to exist. The virtual march contained no anger nor rising emotion, for which common sense sometimes goes out the window, as participants physically merge into sometimes angry groups. Instead, within the privacy of our homes, using desks and computers and telephones, we made our voices heard.

Making new choices and choosing for new outcomes is all that is ahead for Team HomoSapien™. No raucous behavior, mindless milling or tempers flaring; only quiet, caring and knowing powering conscious reality creation. Telephones and digital expression become extensions of what we know to be so.
